




Actor DANNY GLOVER, on Haiti earthquake:











Why is Earth's ice deteriorating so rapidly?

"The atmosphere is warming because of the anthropogenic greenhouse effect. The burning of carbon-based fossil fuels emits carbon dioxide into the atmosphere, and enhances the heat-trapping capability of Earth's atmosphere. .."





"...ice at the top of high mountains is in retreat around the world. Many of the tropical and mid-latitude glaciers, such as those in Africa, the Andes, the Alps, and in the Rocky Mountains will probably disappear in the next few decades. Ice loss is also occurring in the Himalayas, but because of their greater elevations and larger ice mass, some ice will endure beyond the end of the 21st century."






What does the melting of ice mean in terms of sea level rise?

"Just as an ice cube afloat in a beverage glass does not raise the water level in the glass as it melts, neither does the accelerating seasonal melting and breakup of the Arctic sea ice raise sea level directly, because that ice is already afloat in the Arctic Ocean."





"But the melting of Greenland and the mountain glaciers around the world contributes additional water to the oceans, at a rate sufficient to raise sea level approximately 12 centimeters over the course of a century. Such a rise in sea level would on its own be disruptive but not catastrophic. ..."







"But melting ice is not the only cause of an increase in sea level. Two other factors play an even greater role. The first is simply the warming of ocean water around the globe, which causes the sea water to expand. This factor alone contributes more than half of the rise in sea level currently observed. The second factor is the direct loss of ice from Greenland and Antarctica directly into the sea, without first undergoing melting. Such additions of ice raise sea level the moment the ice discharges into the sea. ..."


Fred Thompson for Paul Harvey radio (March 2007): "Some people think that our planet is suffering from a fever. Now scientists are telling us that Mars is experiencing its own planetary warming: Martian warming. It seems scientists have noticed recently that quite a few planets in our solar system seem to be heating up a bit, including Pluto...."

The Message: "Global Warming" is due to *Solar* variations, and not Greenhouse Gases.



Don Neidig of the National Solar Observatory: "Results show a correlation between reconstructed TSI (Total Solar Irradiance) and reconstructed global temperature that is fairly persuasive of a sun-climate link -- up until the 20th century, when again the temperature rises fast and the TSI remains more or less unchanged. ... there is as yet no acceptable evidence for a solar origin for what we call global warming."









Climate Predictions involve hundreds of sources and vetted models; analogy is like estimating life expectancy of 45-year old heavy smoker for insurance policy.







Results of Mann Investigation(s)

February 2010: "Of four allegations, three were dismissed with the statement 'there is no substance to this allegation.' The fourth is an academic matter and has been referred to a panel of faculty peers."

August 2011: "Finding no 'evidence of research misconduct,' the Arlington, Virginia-based National Science Foundation closed its inquiry into Mann, according to an Aug. 15, 2011 report from its inspector general. In February, Pennsylvania State University, where Mann is a professor of meteorology, exonerated him of suppressing or falsifying data, deleting e-mails and misusing privileged information..."

Mann Investigation Update

The Guardian (UK), 2 March 2012:

The two-year legal pursuit of the climate scientist, Michael Mann, by Virginia's climate-sceptic attorney general ran into a dead end at the state supreme court on Friday.

The court rejected Ken Cuccinelli's demand for Mann's email, research notes, and even handwritten memos from his time at the University of Virginia, ruling that the official did not have the legal authority to demand such records



Mann Investigation Update, Cont

The decision was seen as a victory for academic freedom, and a personal embarrassment for Cuccinelli, who had hoped to use his high-profile campaign against the climate scientist to raise his political profile ahead of a run for governorship. Cuccinelli, who dismisses the existence of climate change, has spent two years pursuing Mann through the courts, demanding access to his correspondence with dozens of researchers at other institutions and to grant applications for an investigation into possible fraud. Mann left the University of Virginia in 2005, and now works at Penn State University.

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Global Warming Activist Freezes to Death in Antarctica

Famed global warming activist James Schneider and a journalist friend were both found frozen to death on Saturday, about 90 miles from South Pole Station, by the pilot of a ski plane practicing emergency evacuation procedures.

"I couldn't believe what I was seeing", recounted the pilot, Jimmy Dolittle. "There were two snowmobiles with cargo sleds, a tent, and a bright orange rope that had been laid out on the ice, forming the words, 'HELP-COLD'."

One friend of Prof. Schneider told ecoEnquirer that he had been planning a trip to an ice sheet to film the devastation brought on by global warming. His wife, Linda, said that she had heard him discussing the trip with his environmental activist friends, but she assumed that he was talking about the Greenland ice sheet, a much smaller ice sheet than Antarctica.

"He kept talking about when they 'get down to chili', and I thought they were talking about the order in which they would consume their food supplies", Mrs. Schneider recounted. "I had no idea they were talking about Chile, the country from which you usually fly or sail in order to reach Antarctica."


Apparently, while all of Prof. Schneider's friends were assuming that the July trek would be to Greenland, during Northern Hemisphere summer, his plans were actually to snowmobile to the South Pole - which, in July, is in the dead of winter.

Mr. Dolittle related how some people do not realize that, even if there has been warming in Antarctica, the average temperature at the South Pole in July still runs about 70 degrees F below zero. "Some people think that July is warm everywhere on Earth."








Sargasso Sea paleoclimate data exactly as published as Fig 3. in NIPCC's (anti AGW) 2008 pamphlet.




T(1975) + 0.25 °C = 24.13 °C . RR&S plotted it at 22.9 °C , more than a degree too low.

The "Wegman Report"



In 2006 a team of statisticians led by Edward Wegman, chair of the National Academy of Sciences' (NAS) Committee on Applied and Theoretical Statistics, was assembled at the request of U.S. Rep. Joe Barton and U.S. Rep. Ed Whitfield.



The "Wegman Report"

Findings: MBH98 and MBH99 were found to be "somewhat obscure and incomplete" and the criticisms by McIntyre and McKitrick were found to be "valid and compelling."; Overall, the committee rejected Mann's assessment that the 1990s was the hottest decade of the millennium, and that 1998 was the hottest year of the millennium.

Asked by Rep. Jan Schakowsky about the greenhouse mechanism, Wegman replied: "Carbon dioxide is heavier than air. Where it sits in the atmospheric profile, I don't know. I'm not an atmospheric scientist to know that. But presumably... if the carbon dioxide is close to the surface of the earth, it's not reflecting a lot of infra-red back..."



Mark Boslough, SNL: "In 2005, Sen. James Inhofe (R-OK) called global warming the 'greatest hoax ever perpetrated on the American people.' Rep. Joe Barton, (R-TX) joined the assault by harassing three respected climate scientists, ..."







"Edward Wegman—a statistician with no background in climatology and little understanding of physics—led the investigation. Wegman's team submitted a report that criticized the statistical methods used by the scientists. Denialists embraced this criticism, claiming that the hockey stick has been discredited and declaring that global warming was a fraud. ..."



"Scientists play by well defined rules. They require peer reviewed publication, logic, and evidence. Science is like a hockey game that only works if fans understand it and teams play by the rules. Inhofe and Barton knew their side could not win against a world-class 'hockey team.' They chose instead to create confusion and sow doubt. ..."



"Their tactic was to act like unruly fans and throw hundreds of decoy pucks onto the ice and then take advantage of the chaos. The idea was simply to delay any action in order to protect vested interests in the status quo. They didn't have to win the game. All they needed to do is disrupt it by turning it into one big 'ClusterPuck'. ..."



"Scientists were understandably angry and were not always circumspect in their private messages. They did not expect political activists—willing to tap phones and break into computers—to steal their correspondence. ... This non-scandal became known as 'ClimateGate.' ..."



"The actual scandal is associated with the Barton investigation. [In Jan. 2010] a blogger called 'Deep Climate' demonstrated that, in a cruel irony, the Wegman team actually plagiarized from a textbook written by one of the scientists [Bradley] under investigation. Even worse, they changed the meaning of the text they stole. ..."



"The supposedly unbiased referees of the game were part of the ClusterPuck. ... Will the media investigate and report the 'ClusterPuck' scandal as aggressively as they did for the 'ClimateGate' non-scandal? Or is there a journalistic double standard that favors deniers?"





Mark Boslough's column "Climate-change deniers ignore science" in the January 24th, 2011 Santa Fe New Mexican:



Regarding former astronaut and senator Harrison Schmitt, who had been nominated for the secretary of Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department by Governor Susana Martinez



Boslough: "In 2009, Schmitt submitted a white paper to NASA. He stated, 'Artic (sic) sea ice has returned to 1989 levels of coverage.' I wrote to him, politely pointing out that this was not true, and directing him to the data from the National Snow and Ice Data Center (the ice extent in 2009 had not recovered, and as of this writing is at an alltime winter low). ..."



Boslough, continued: "He [Schmitt] responded, but never made the necessary correction. Anyone can make a mistake, but scientific integrity requires that authors own up to mistakes and fix them."



A week later, Joseph Bast of the Heartland Institute (which Boslough describes as a "right-wing organization that actively engages in attacks on objective scientific findings"), published an opposing op-ed in the New Mexican. **January 31, 2011** THE HEARTLAND

Bast wrote "Unlike Boslough and his allies, global-warming realists don't, by implication, compare people who disagree with them to Holocaust deniers. That is a disgusting rhetorical trick that is likely and perhaps even calculated to inflame the emotions of people, some of whom may be mentally unbalanced."


National Snow and Ice Data Center, cont'd Sea ice conditions can vary from month to month, but overall we see the continuation of a strong downward trend. You can read our 2009 season analysis at nsidc.org/news/press/20091005 minimumpr.html. While 2009 Arctic sea ice extent did briefly exceed 1989 levels in April and May, it was substantially less than 1989 the rest of the year.



National Snow and Ice Data Center, cont'd The 2009 maximum extent, minimum extent, and annual average extent values were all well below 1989. Based on these facts, it would be incorrect to suggest that 2009 represented a recovery of Arctic sea ice to 1989 levels. ... Walt Meier and Mark Serreze are senior research scientists at National Snow and Ice Data Center, University of Colorado at Boulder."

As part of NCSE's expansion to defend the teaching of climate science, Gleick had earlier agreed to join NCSE's board of directors. His resignation was accepted.

Mashey: In 2009, Science derided Heartland for sending copies of The Skeptic's Handbook to 14,000 US school board officials. Heartland's Environment and Climate New[s] mocked one school board president for his refusal to use it. But Heartland began its classroom misinformation campaign much earlier. And it's always worth remembering that Heartland President Joe Bast vigorously defended Joe Camel (the most successful campaign to get kids to smoke younger) ... And then asked for more money. The only real surprise for me in 2012 documents was fact that Heartland is now getting more cigarette money than in 2001.

At NMSR, Henry Pollack talked about the need for leveling the playing field between carbon-based and non-carbon-based energy sources; currently, he said carbon-based fuels are dumping CO2 into the atmosphere as if it were an 'open sewer,' with no penalties assessed for this very real pollution.



Regarding those who say that climate warming will continue even if carbon emissions were stopped today, Pollack said it is a matter of degree. If we act now, the oceans may rise several inches, displacing millions of people. But, failing to act now could mean the oceans will rise several feet, displacing perhaps billions.



In regards to the East Anglia e-mail "scandal", Pollack pointed out that global climate science is performed by many agencies and universities besides this small school. Even if every scientist at East Anglia was a conniving cheater, many scientists at NOAA, NSF, IPCC, and universities worldwide are not. While some of the leaked exchanges were quite rude, Henry pointed out that Isaac Newton may have also been rude, but he was correct about gravity regardless."
